Step 7: Make a fashion statement





Early Results

Usage Savings:

- Water: 14% - 38.9%

– Energy: 14% – 65%

Trash: 1 pick up per week per property

Cost Savings:

– Water: 18% – 23%

– Energy: 15% – 77%

- Trash: 20% - 25%



Lessons Learned

- Keep it Simple
- Integrate Green into Existing Work
- Repetition is Key
- Peer Pressure Matters
- Integration and Change Take Time
- Pilot Projects Test Success and Problems
- Recognition is Critical
