


2. NYS-DEC Active Chemical Bulk /Major Oil Storage Facilities


Facilities storing hazardous substances, or capacity to store 400k gallons of oil



Category 3; storm surge 14.8-25 ft; winds 111-130 mph

Category 4; storm surge 24.6-31.3 ft; winds 131 mph or more






